Please do not bring cell phones or iPads to camp. We want campers to stay present, engaged and fully enjoy their summer experience.

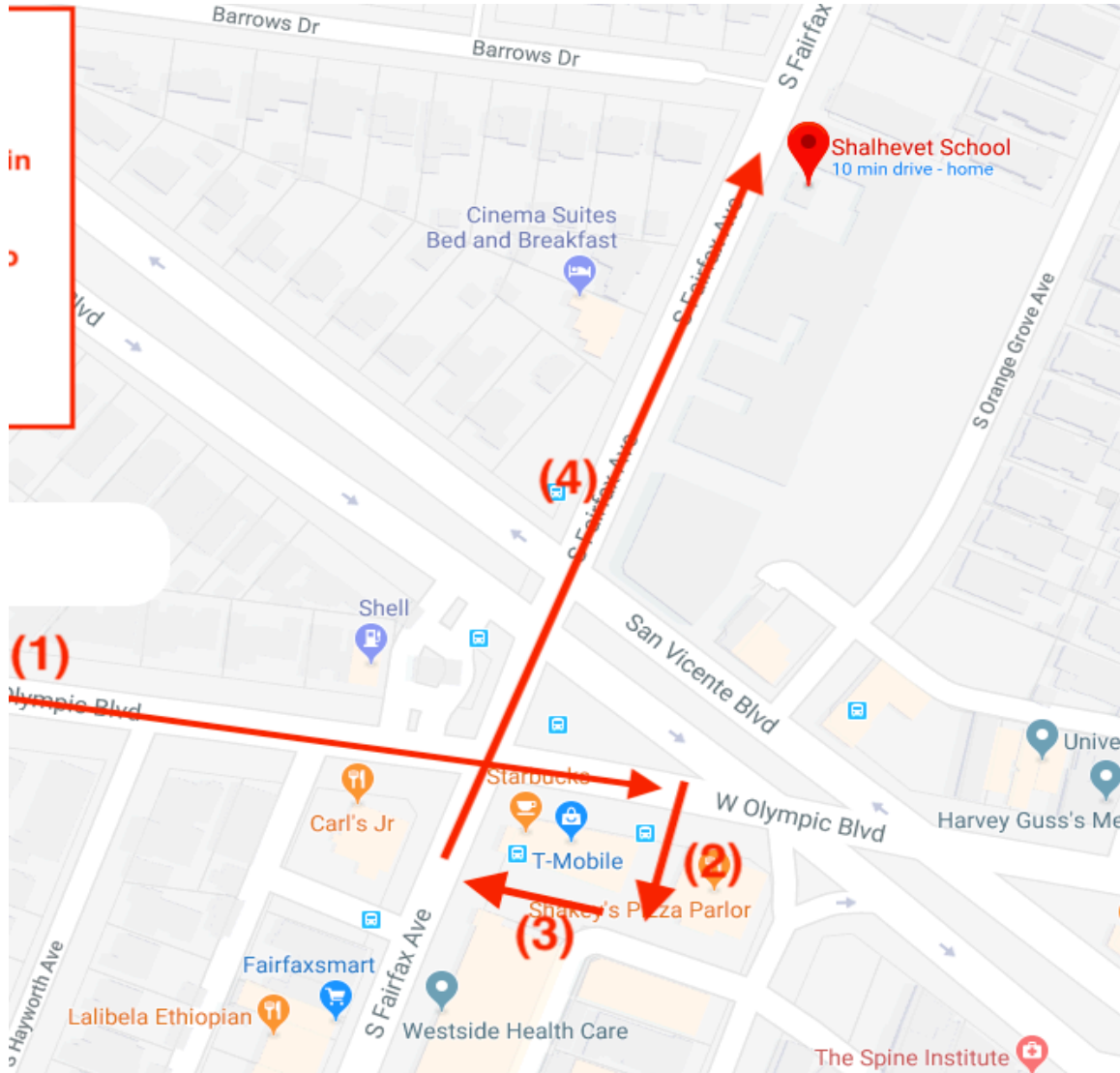

CARPOOL FOR SHALHEVET CAMPUS

A) Drop off & pick-up will take place in the front of the Shalhevet campus

- B) The carpool entrance is located right off of Olympic Blvd. (Please see attached diagram with instructions below)
- C) **Absolutely NO PARKING/LEAVING YOU CAR in the carpool line.**
- D) Please do not honk your horns

1. Head East on Olympic Blvd
2. Pass Fairfax Ave. and turn right into the T-Mobile parking lot
3. Make another quick right and head straight to Fairfax Ave.
4. Turn right onto Fairfax Ave.
